STANDING RULES

The following standing rules (otherwise know as policies) are to be given out along with our membership list and By-Laws to any new member

9/60 The club will not accept a judge (for the point show) without an advance statement of his or her fees or expenses.

2/72 The committee recommended that membership pins be purchased and the award for champions should be either a tie tack or charm to be given out for the period 12/1 to 12/1 at the Christmas party. A template was discussed to be purchased and medallions affixed to trophies (this medallion was placed on plates and given to speakers at meetings)

11/73 Free lunch at point shows and match shows be eliminated except for judges, officiating veterinarians, superintendents, AKC representative, professional stewards, obedience and breed chair persons. Cash rebates for outside help at point shows. (Boy scouts, etc.)

amended 6/82 to read "All members working at the point show who work 1/2 day or more will receive a lunch ticket. Those working all morning will be given coffee and doughnuts or sweet rolls prior to the start of judging.

1/94 To eliminate the judges selection committee and have one club member hire the judges for both point shows. Motion made by Donna Webster, she then volunteered to take on this task.

amended 4/97 to read two club members hire the judges for both point shows.

4/61 The AKC delegate make a formal report of each AKC meeting either in person or by sending in a written report to be read at our meeting.

11/61 We ban all handlers from puppy matches except Club members showing their own puppies and that at our regular all breed match show all handlers may show only their own dogs or those of members of their immediate family for which they furnish proof of ownership.

4/69 Any member who sells a dog to a pet shop, will be dropped from the club if the sale can be proven.

4/70 Deceased members - Annual contribution to the Virus Research Lab (Baker Inst.) is made in their memory. Point Shows may be dedicated to the deceased.

6/72 Championship awards are for AKC championships only.

Amended 9/77 to include Canadian championships.

5/74 AKC Delegate, ADCNYS delegate and any other person designed by the club to serve as a delegate with expenses paid shall submit an itemized expense account for each meeting attended within 30 days immediately following said meeting.

Board of Directors shall recommend total amount of donations to be awarded in a given year.

Telephone bills - bills shall be submitted in writing including person called, place, date and cost. If at all possible all communication should be done by letter.

6/75 Policy list to be attached to By-Laws

The FLKC may award the Ken'I Ration Award each year.

Bank signature card to be secured by Treasurer to be signed by the President as well as the Treasurer and Secretary.

8/77 Juniors (children) of FLKC members may come to meetings as guests to hear speakers of particular interest.

Juniors may attend handling classes free of charge, as long as their parent(s) are FLKC members.

The practice of giving gifts to juniors who help at the match and point shows will be abandoned. A thank you note will be sent to each child instead.

Initiation fees paid by new members on or after the October meeting will be credited as full dues payment for the following year.

3/79 The board of directors has made the motion that the treasurer of the club be bonded. Passed

- 6/79 Each committee chairman must review and revise his/her job description and this is to be handed down from chairman to chairman with all additions no later than the January meeting each year.**
- 7/84 The ethics is to be attached to the membership application.**
- 11/85 Motion to amend the by-laws, to strike the dollar amount in reference to dues.**
- 3/87 The show chairman should present BIS trophy; persons who donate trophies for first in group shall first be asked to present their respective trophies, if they are not available the ring steward shall present the trophy.**
- 2/88 A motion was made to transfer money from the "Sandy Borow" account to the Shearson account, with money withdrawn yearly for the memorial trophy.**
- 4/88 The show chairman, show co-chairman, hospitality chairman, chief steward, and president of both the kennel and obedience clubs not be able to show.**
- 7/88 Any monies earned from educational activities be put back into the education committee fund.**
- 11/91 Sunshine committee to include awards for member owned Best In Shows. The club give a picture frame to any member whose dog takes a BIS.**
- 2/92 May hire the stewards for both of our shows. Passed.**
- 11/92 The Fagan funds should be kept in a separate account and any unused interest should be rolled over into that account.**
- The suggestions for use of the interest each year from the Fagan funds should be handled by the Board.**
- 6/93 All programs start at 7:30 P.M. and the business meeting to follow. If there is no program, we will have a social time between 7:30 and 8:00 pm (Board meeting will start at 7:00 PM)**
- 6/94 Treasurer is not to pay any bill without an invoice first.**
- 10/94 The Board would like to recommend that the club accept the suggestion to make the people who sponsor new members be the new members mentor, helping them to feel at home and guiding them into a committee to help with. Passed.**
